

2015-2016 Anderson Band Booster Volunteer Positions

The ABB (Anderson Band Booster) Organization asks for every family to be involved in filling open positions that are vital in supporting our 120+ member Pride of AHS Marching Band and Colorguard, and Concert Bands programming. *Specific participation requests for the marching band season will be sent in a separate communication before the start of band camp.*

The following describes all of the Events/Committees/Volunteer opportunities open currently, and for the school year 2016-2017.

After Prom Band Room Chair (Jenna Miller/Julie Bridges/Katie Couzins)

1-2 Chairs, with a handful of helpers, choose a design that works within the overall theme for After Prom. Band Room for after prom is located in a small section of the cafeteria closest to the food service doors. Involves design of room, set-up of table service and tear-down of the room.

Band Camp Activities Coordinator (Lindsay Keeling)

This person works directly with the executive board and band directors to coordinate activities during the two weeks of band camp. (Aug)

Band Expo – (Chair needed in Fall 2016)

Band Expo is held each fall and is an adjudicated OMEA sanctioned SW Ohio event. The annual Marching Band competition commissioned by the Forest Hills Instrumental Music Association (FHIMA), is held at Anderson High School. Anderson High School, Turpin High School, and Nagel Middle School are host bands.

Band Extravaganza – (Sharon Kabbes Chrisman, New Chair needed for 2017 & 2018)

Assist an existing team in ABB's biggest fundraiser of the year. The event features performances by Anderson High School Bands and Colorguard; Ayer, Maddux and Summit Elementary Schools; and includes Nagel Middle School during **odd** number years. Along with good music there's; great food, cash prizes, silent auction, and raffle. Committee positions vary. We start work in Jan/Feb, and have no more than 4 meetings from beginning to end.

Road Rally Mailing Mgr. Road Rally Raffle Ticket Mgr. Program typesetting, Silent Auction/Raffle, Band Bistro concession, Publicity (includes event t-shirt coordination).

30+ overall volunteers are required for a successful event.

Bus Chaperones – (Chair needed for Fall 2016)

The chaperone chairperson working with band directors, coordinates needs throughout the Marching Band and Colorguard away game and competition season. It is convenient for bus

chaperones to also assist with uniforms or Pit.

FHIMA Liaison (Debbie Sangermano)

This person is the liaison between the ABB and FHIMA. They will attend monthly FHIMA meetings and report to the ABB what is happening within the district.

Food Team (3-4 Team Captains and Water Captain needed) Missy Moyers

The Food Team creates 4 equal number Food Teams assigned by instrument/group section of band and colorguard. They create sign ups at first parent meeting of the fall season, create calendar schedule for each food team, communicate needs through SignUp Genius/ email, coordinate food offerings/snacks for home games, away games and competitions. Each member is responsible for staffing the food table on their scheduled night.

Membership – (Chair needed for 2016-2017)

This is a Chairperson position which requires you to disseminate information about joining the Boosters organization at the end of the school year, and collect the Membership Dues associated with the Anderson Band Boosters, working with the Treasurer to make deposits.

Pit Crew/Pit – Chairs (Tony Kabbes / Tom Turner)

Pit is the arms, legs and muscles behind the delivery of percussion/pit instruments and props to the field for all performances (games and competitions). Assist in unloading and loading of all equipment, instruments, props and uniform extras. (Aug-Nov)

Photography (Karen King Debry)

Several photographers are needed to take pictures of the band members and their activities at several events throughout the year, but primarily during the Fall during marching season, including the weeks of band camp. If you like to snap digital photos, this is the group for you! The result of the efforts is a slideshow shown during the Marching Band Awards Banquet. If you like arranging music and photos into a nice memory for the band members and their families, then you might consider being a slide show segment editor. (Aug-May)

Popcorn Coordinator – (Anne Stratman)

This person is responsible for purchase of popcorn supplies, setting up the machine at home games near concessions, cleaning, storage and scheduling volunteers via SignUp Genius. Volunteers help make popcorn, fill bags, and handle cash sales. (Aug-May)

Publicity (Nancy Hands)

Chairperson position who will work with the Board to obtain photographs (from the Photography team) and decide which stories we would like to submit to the School website and the local newspapers for recognition and promotion of events. Final approval will be through the Band Directors. (Aug-May)

Scholarships – (Mary Beth Tummler)

Consists of a chair, plus 1 parent from each grade level, plus director Toby Biederman, who assist in reviewing applicants. Scholarships to be used for musical advancement are available ONE each per school grade. (April-May)

A chair plus small committee working with executive board, parents and students to coordinate the following activities:

Spirit Team (Isa Vasquez)

This committee is responsible for making locker signs, banners and spread spirit throughout the stands. They will make banners prior to each competition to encourage the students and get them excited about their upcoming performance. They may also assist the Special Events Chair with banquet decorations. (Aug-May)

Spirit Wear – (Chair needed for Fall 2016)

This person(s) compiles a list of items to be made available during the marching season, including favorite items as well as something fun and new. Our long-standing relationship with our supplier makes this job fun and easy. Compiles orders, collects money and delivers and hands out orders at school in a timely manner. (Aug)

Spring Musical Band Rep (Mary Beth Tummler, Chair needed for Spring 2017)

This liaison position is typically held by a marching band and colorguard parent who is also a theater parent. They coordinate needs of both groups and look for schedule conflicts, acting in the best interest of both groups. (Aug-May)

Sunshine – Chair (Shirley Soudrette, Chair needed for Fall 2016)

This position is perfect for the person who likes to spread a little happiness to the members of the band, families of the band and will be responsible of sending cards, coordinating Popsicle

Thursdays once Band Camp ends thru the month of September/October depending upon the weather. (Aug-May)

Uniforms (Lindsay Keeling/Katie Couzins)

The uniform committee is responsible for organizing, distributing and maintaining uniforms before and after performances throughout the year. Additionally, the committee manages and schedules 'beginning of year' uniform fittings and 'end of year' uniform cleaning. (Aug-Nov, May)
